Public Health attestation</p> <p>I, the undersigned official veterinarian declare that I am aware of the relevant provisions of Regulations (EC) Nos 178/2002, 852/2004, 853/2004 and 2160/2003 and hereby certify that the eggs described in this certificate have been obtained in accordance with those requirements, and in particular that:</p> <p>II.2.1 they come from (an) establishments(s) implementing a programme based on the HACCP principles in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 852/2004;</p> <p>II.2.2 they have been kept, stored, transported and delivered in accordance with the relevant conditions laid down in Section X, Chapter I of Annex III to Regulation (EC) No 853/2004;</p> <p>(1) [II.2.2.1 they fulfil the requirements of Commission Regulation (EC) No 1688/2005 implementing Regulation (EC) No 853/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards special guarantees concerning Salmonella for consignments to Finland and Sweden of certain meat and eggs or the requirements of Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 427/2012 on the extension of special guarantees concerning Salmonella laid down in Regulation (EC) No 853/2004 to eggs intended for dispatch to Denmark;]</p> <p>II.2.3 the guarantees covering live animals and products thereof provided by the residue plans submitted in accordance with Directive 96/23/EC, and in particular Article 29 thereof, are fulfilled;</p> <p>II.2.4 they fulfil the requirements in Article 10(6) of Regulation (EC) No 2160/2003.
